## PARKS AND RECREATION

### BRANDON PARK

1612 Keltys Street  
Community center, picnic area, basketball court, volleyball court, wading pool.

### CHAMBERS PARK

500 Pershing Avenue  
A large wooded park that has been updated with a Spray Play facility and a new pavilion. The park has been adopted by the Angelina Rotary Club and renovation was coordinated by the Lufkin Landscape Task Force.  
Pavilion, band stand, picnic area, playground, restroom, tennis courts, spray play pad, community center.

### ELLEN TROUT PARK

North Loop 287  
One of Lufkin's premier park facilities. It has a zoo, a miniature train, a beautiful lake stocked for fishing, and modern playground equipment. The park abounds with wildlife complementing the zoo. There are lots of picnic areas well suited for family and organization activities.

### FOUR SEASONS PARK

Park is a large open field.

### GRACE DUNNE RICHARDSON PARK

200 Mott Drive  
Connected to the Azalea Trail, this park is a great place to exercise by walking, jogging, or cycling. The park is well suited for medium to large group events.

### HERTY PARK

400 McHale Street  
One of Lufkin's finest small parks and is well suited for family and organization activities.  
Pavilion, picnic area, playground, restroom, softball field, basketball court, volleyball court, soccer field, trail.

### JONES PARK

1502 MLK Street  
Recently upgraded, the park has a large, lighted, covered basketball court, resurfaced tennis courts, a stocked fishing lake, and a swimming pool. Picnic areas are well suited for family and organization activities.  
Pavilion, band stand, picnic area, playground, restroom, swimming pool, basketball court, volleyball court, lake/fishing, trail.

### KIT MCCONNICO PARK

903 Moffet Road  
Primarily dedicated to team sports, Kit McConnico Park has seven softball fields and 11 youth soccer fields. Restrooms and concessions complement the area during league and tournament games. The Lufkin Bicycle Coalition constantly improves mountain bike trails in the park.

### KIWANIS PARK

1117 S. Timberland Drive  
Centrally-located park with a spray play facility and disc golf. An ideal park for family and organization activities. Adopted by the Kiwanis Club, the park is home to the annual Cinco de Mayo Festival.  
Pavilion, gazebo, picnic area, playground, restroom, spray play pad, basketball court, tennis court, volleyball court, trail.

The United Hispanic Soccer League of East Texas currently calls the fields home, until expansion by Lufkin Youth Baseball, will move them to a new facility at Richardson Park. East Texas Football League also plays on a field. The park is connected by a trail to the Wetland Garden and Outdoor Classroom.  
Pavilion, wetland garden, wetland elevated walkway, concession stand, playground, restroom, baseball field, soccer field, wetland trail, outdoor classroom.

### WARD STREET PARK

Ward Street Park is a small neighborhood park located in a growing revitalized area. An excellent practice facility for small baseball or softball teams, the park playground is perfect for warming up or cooling down.
